MULTIPLICATION WAR



Play Multiplication War with a partner and a deck of cards. Each person should draw two cards from the top of the deck and multiply your two cards together. The person who has the highest product gets to keep all 4 cards. If there is a tie, draw again and the winner keeps all 8 cards. Each number card is worth its own number. Jacks, Queens, and Kings are worth II, and Aces are worth I2. Whoever has the most cards after you have gone through the entire deck wins the game.
